

Foundation: 1905



"The Parish began in 1905, in a Protestant church building, at the corner of Keefer Street and Campbell Avenue. This building was destroyed by fire in 1948, and a new building opened on the same site in 1949.."

I. Historical Background [1905 - 1936]

The Parish began in 1905, in a Protestant church building, at the corner of Keefer Street and Campbell Avenue. This building was destroyed by fire in 1948, and a new building opened on the same site in 1949. This building was remodelled and renovated for the one hundredth anniversary.

The parish supports St. Paul's Church in Vancouver as a mission. Sacred Heart also supports Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha Catholic Native Centre at 887 Keefer Street, next door to the church, welcoming urban First Nations people to worship and care. This ministry is served by Rev. Ken Foster, OMI; Rev. Aloys Luken, OMI; and Brother Ed Lynch.

As well, the parish operates the Agape Street Ministry. Workers walk through the neighborhood every night, reaching out to hundreds of streetwalkers, giving them a bag of candy, calling them by name, remembering them on their birthdays with a small gift, praying with them, and encouraging them to take the step to recovery. Agape operates two transition houses in the Metro Vancouver area.

II. Stigmatines serving in the Parish [1936 - 1952]

In 1936, the Stigmatine Congregation started serving the parish. Fr. Joachim Bortignon, CPS was the first Stigmatine Pastor, for the next 15 years, leaving there in 1951.

Fr. Camillo Santini, CPS succeeded Fr. Bortignon as Pastor, until the year 1952, when the Stigmatines left the Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish.

The list of Pastor and Religious who have served the parish is present in Appendix 10.1.

In 1940, the parish opened a school at 884 East Pender Street, serverd by Sisters of Charity of the Immaculate Conception of Saint John, New Brunswick. The school closed in 1983. Lay organizations include the Catholic Women's League (1952 - 1990, led by the Salesians), and the Legion of Mary (established in 1994, and led by Dan O'Reilly).

The month of June is dedicated to The Sacred Heart of Jesus.

As we begin to feel the warmth of summer, we can reflect that we celebrate the feasts of Corpus Christi (June 2), the Sacred Heart of Jesus (June 7) and the Immaculate Heart of Mary (June 8). God is Love and the Sacred Heart of Jesus - present on earth in the Blessed Sacrament - is the human manifestation of God's Love for men. Appropriately June is considered the month for weddings where human hearts join and cooperate with the Creator in bringing forth new life. The family they create is a human reflection of the Blessed Trinity.

Following Pentecost, the Church begins her slow descent from the great peaks of the Easter Season to the verdant pastures of Ordinary Time, the longest of the liturgical seasons. She pauses briefly, to praise the Holy Trinity - Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier; and then the Sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. Like the lush June growth all around us, the green of the liturgical season points to the new life won for us by the Redemption of Jesus Christ, the new life of Charity. For Our Lord came to cast the fire of His love on the earth, and to that end, sent, His Holy Spirit at Pentecost in the form of tongues of fire.

Therefore, the close of the Easter season marks not the cessation but rather the beginning of Ordinary Time is the commencement of the Church's activity. Ordinary Time is the hour to "go out to all the world and tell the good news." The feasts of June highlight this expansion of the Church. At least ten times, the Church vests in the red of the martyrs whose blood is the very seed of her growth. She also celebrates the feasts of the Apostles Peter and Paul, and the birth of St. John the Baptist, proto-disciple and prophet.

We, too, are called to be witnesses like the apostles and martyrs. May the Heart of Jesus inflame our hearts so that we may be worthy of our Baptismal call to holiness. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.


Masses and Prayer Sessions


